











"Smart City Chernivtsi 2025"

The Chernivtsi City Council has given its approval to the Smart City Chernivtsi 2025 idea, a cutting-edge approach to city administration built on the use of the newest technologies.

The overall quality of life of city residents will increase with the implementation of the Smart City Chernivtsi 2025 idea. A cutting-edge service delivery system will be introduced, and an atmosphere that is conducive to business and investment attractiveness will be created.

The Schumpeter School of Innovation

The Schumpeter School of Innovation opened its doors in Chernivtsi in September 2021. Its strategic goal is to assist business owners and public administration sector representatives in acquiring managerial skills and useful management tools as well as systematizing and scaling business and public administration. The Schumpeter School of Innovation collaborates with the Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University and the Chernivtsi City Council and brings together the top academics from Ukrainian business institutions.

Center for Bukovynian Innovative Technologies named after J. Schumpeter "Cluster bit"

The cluster was established to bring like-minded individuals together around intriguing and potential IT projects for Chernivtsi's long-term growth. In coordination with the local government, the IT cluster organization plan was put into action. The objective is to develop cutting-edge technologies, build a cutting-edge innovation infrastructure in Chernivtsi and the surrounding area, popularize the startup movement, and raise the attractiveness of IT firms as an investment.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE RIVER PRUT EMBANKMENT

Location:

the area bounded by Belorusska, Prutska, Mashynobudivnykiv, Izmailivska streets and the river Prut in Chernivtsi

The main goal of the project:

- development of the city beach
- arrangement of a camping site, sports grounds
- laying of a bicycle path (loop path) on the dam

Description:

The ancient city center and the river's Prut scenery are connected by the river Prut embankment, one of the biggest and most significant sites with significant development potential. The role of these sites as green recreational spaces needs to be strengthened. To achieve this, a type of multipurpose district where people can live and work should be developed, and the river Prut embankment's growth will produce a desirable environment for leisure and recreation.



WASTE MANAGEMENT CENTER

The main goal of the project:

Establishment of a waste management center with a sorting station and a VB 750 shredder designed to shred various types of waste: household, mixed, industrial, and construction waste.

Every municipal resident is welcome to send their solid garbage to the Municipal garbage Management Center for free processing or disposal. The activities of the Center will assist in lowering the amount of garbage going to landfills, progressively resolving the problem of disposing of bulky waste.
